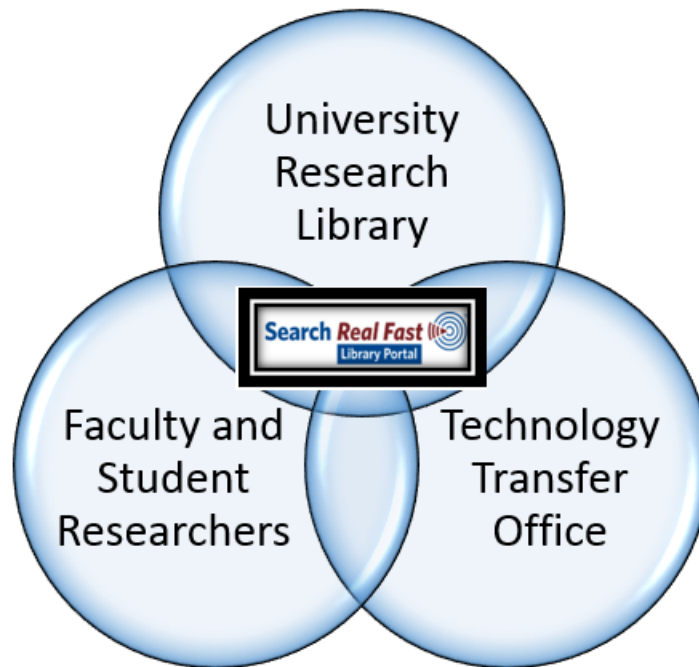

DALLAS (SMU) – Search Real Fast, a self-directed online technology and patent search service, will announce its Library Portal product at the AUTM 2016 Annual Meeting in San Diego.



“Our Search Real Fast Library Portal is the result of good feedback from the AUTM community and many hours of work from our development team,” said Jim Hummel, Director of Business Development for Search Real Fast. “Although not released in time for us to exhibit at a booth, Shannon Pestka and I will be attending the AUTM Conference to personally introduce the Library Portal. We look forward to visiting with many in the AUTM community.”

The current Search Real Fast product provides keyword identification and automated search script building for over a hundred commonly-used public databases. In addition, it provides a history log of all searches and comprehensive Snapshot Reports of research milestones. Therefore, the researcher does not have to manually keep up with search activity and has dated documentation to submit as needed.

Now with the Library Portal, university researchers can use the power of Search Real Fast with many of the paid, subscription databases that are available through their university research libraries. Many technology transfer offices work jointly with their university libraries to sponsor training on prior art and patent searching.

Now the Search Real Fast Library Portal offers a more direct way to connect the university research database sources with the commercialization of research ideas that is the driving mission of the TTO.
